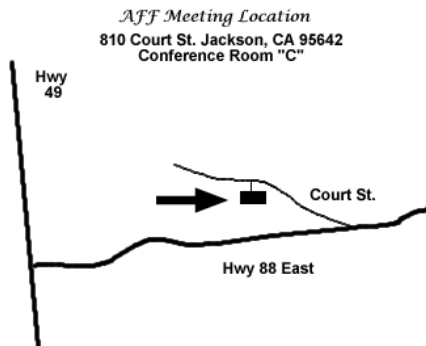

Amador Flyfishers

Is a family-oriented organization established in 1991 to provide an opportunity for persons interested in fly fishing to share information, learn from others, experience fly fishing in various locations, and protect fisheries for future generations.



Objectives:

- To foster and promote the sport of angling with artificial flies
- To teach and share knowledge and techniques involved in fly fishing
- To organize and lead fishing trips
- To promote and support the conservation of fisheries

Activities

Amador Flyfishers participate in a wide variety of activities throughout the year and share information through a monthly newsletter.

General Meetings

The general meetings cover topics of interest and concern to fly fishers, ranging from fly fishing techniques for all skill levels to finding good fishing locations. Speakers include fly casting and fly tying experts, fly rod builders, fishing guides, community representatives, government officials, and occasionally our own members who have a particular skill or interest to share with the group. A raffle of fly fishing related items is conducted as part of our fundraising efforts.

Fishing Opportunities

Numerous fishing trips varying in length from one to several days are scheduled throughout the year on lakes and streams. The trips are designed to provide a broad range of experiences for attendees. Novices learn from more experienced fishers how to read the water, identify insects on which fish are feeding, and various casting and retrieval techniques. Most trips are not physically strenuous although we do try to include at least one trip each year that provides opportunity to fish in an unspoiled area.

Clinics

Throughout the year, fly tying clinics and casting practice may be held immediately prior to the general meeting. In addition, other clinics are frequently held in conjunction with special events.

Annual Picnic

In late spring we hold a family picnic and fishing outing. The club provides some of the food while members supplement the basics with special potluck dishes of their own. A casting clinic for youths and beginners is held in the morning, followed by actual practice on the water.

Annual Dinner

In late winter we get together for a catered dinner including a special presentation.

Other Activities

As opportunities arise, we participate in special activities such as providing community assistance for youth groups or restoration of fishing areas.

AFF Website

AFF maintains an internet website to keep our members informed about recent and upcoming club activities. The website also provides a wide variety of information relating to fly fishing and fisheries conservation (including fishing trips, fly tying, fly casting, and activities of interest being conducted by other organizations.
